Selection Criteria 2026 for the 75th Lindau Nobel Laureate Meeting Interdisciplinary (Chemistry, Physics and Medicine/Physiology)

These young participants will be recruited among Chinese doctoral students within Chinese domestic institutions (PhD. candidates scheduled to graduate on or after July 1, 2027).

The following standards and criteria have been defined for their selection:

All nominated participants shall

- 1. show a genuine interest and engagement in science and research,
- 2. show a noble aspiration to participate in international research cooperation, particularly in German universities and institutes,
- 3. belong to the top 5 percent of their class,
- 4. be fluent in English and prepared to actively participate in discussions with the Nobel laureates and young scientists,
- 5. already have published papers in scientific journals (First Author an asset), and/or have made reports in international academic conferences,
- not already have completed doctoral thesis, not already have a permanent position (for this, the professional/employment status must be clearly indicated),
- 7. not have participated in a previous Lindau Meeting,
- 8. be not older than 32 years of age at the date of the meeting with exceptions for special cases (after June 28, 1994).

We welcome applications of doctoral students, who are studying research at the intersection of at least two Nobel disciplines(chemistry, physics and physiology or medicine) or at the intersection of one Nobel discipline and another discipline from the social or natural sciences.
